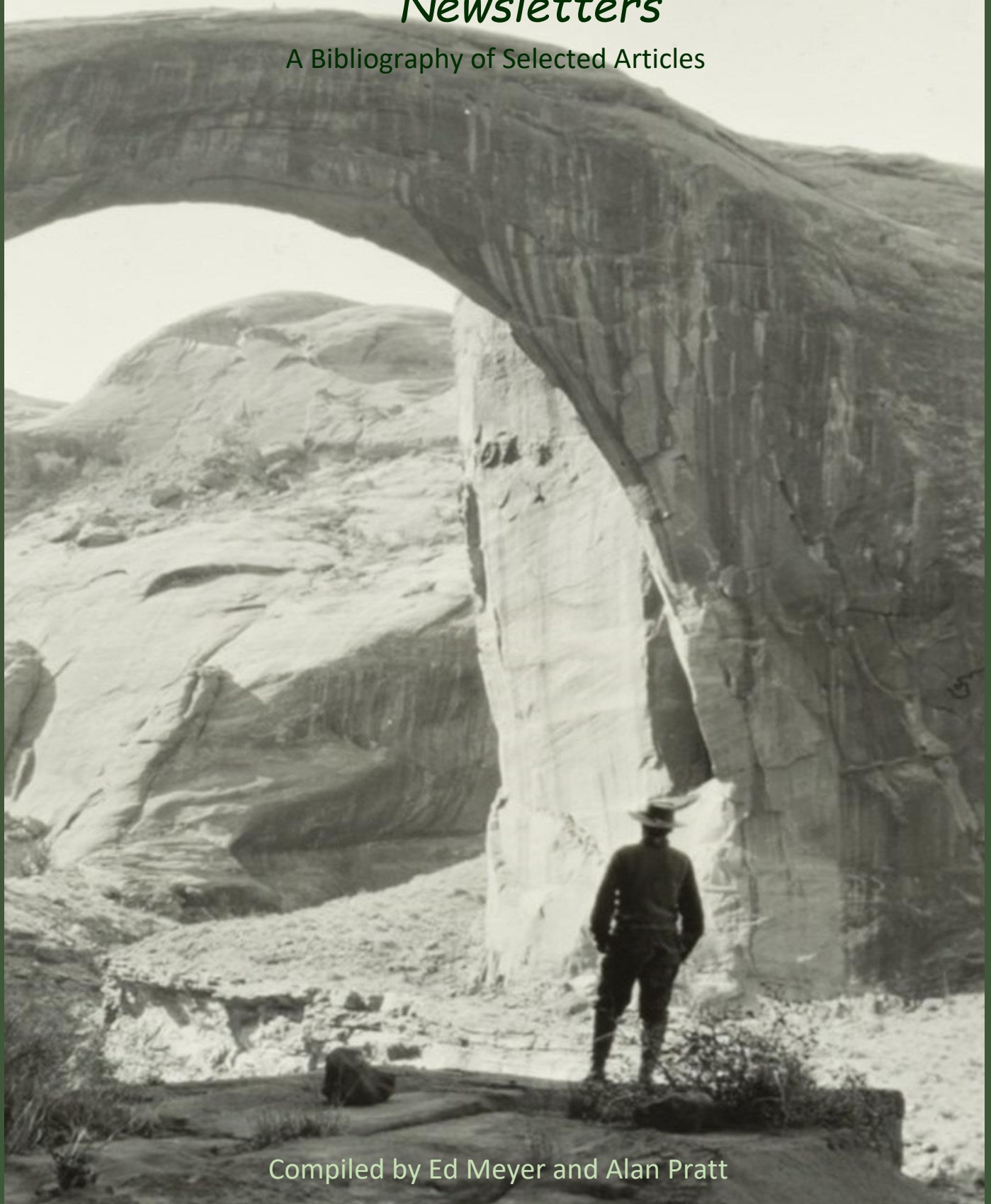

# Introduction

The easiest way to describe the *Guide* is a selected bibliography of articles relating to Zane Grey that appeared in newsletters initially published by noted Grey researcher G.M. Farley and the Zane Grey's West Society between 1968 and 2021. Pieces chosen for the *Guide* focus on

Here's what one will not find in the *Guide*. Though the articles referenced appeared primarily in one of the newsletters of Zane Grey's West Society, there are few-articles about Society events and business. Similarly, articles relating to the passing of Society members, book reports, fiction, and other topics of little appeal to a researcher are limited.

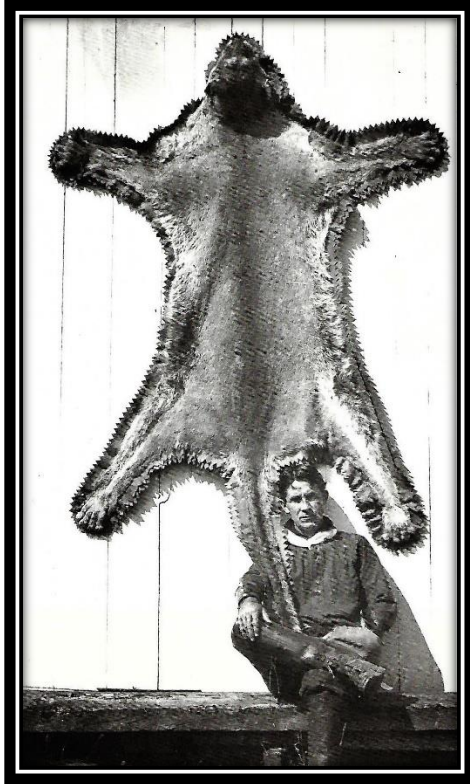
